Treasurer's report-

In November and December we raised \$1,000 for 350 Seattle from the rummage sale(s), \$347.21 for Community Lunch from the bake sale, and \$281.50 for Operation NightWatch (1/2 of the Christmas Eve offering of \$563). We have also raised about \$3,000 in special fundraising for Prospect, which is double our budget. Year-to-date income is ahead of budget due mostly to unplanned income. Both loose offering and facility use donations are under budget. Year-to-date expenses are under budget, so the year-to-date deficit is also under budget. We have taken the Osgood and Parker Cook 5% contributions (in January).

Trustee's Report Annual maintenance budget is over Roof consultation is over budget- not really possible to budget for this item Roof repair-

Organ repair- about \$3,000- \$4,000

Ralph will get estimates for repair from the people who were recommended by the retired organ repair person.
